- 1. Look at the headings
- 2. Look at the pictures Is there any other information under them?
- 3. Is there any by-line or text under the title of the article?
- 4. Look at the first paragraph This should give you an overview of the article's direction
- 5. Skim the passage to get the main ideas and the theme focusing on the topic sentences
- 6. Underline the topic sentences for each paragraph Note that not all topic sentences will be in the first line of the paragraph
- 7. Write a summary of each paragraph
- 8. Scan for key words Sometimes these key words are highlighted, have capital letters or numbers, and sometimes they use a different word with the same meaning to the one that you are looking for. Use your summaries to find the paragraph that you are looking for.
- 9. Learn how to match headings to paragraphs you have already prepared for this when you write your summaries
- 10. Short answer questions
